Specifications for the 2019 Architecture for Health Gallery Complimentary Printing by ASHE for your 1 Project Design Proof Due: January 11, 2019

Below are some suggestions, rules, and conditions for your 39" x 70" board, which will be displayed at both the 2019 PDC Summit and ASHE Annual Conference and Technical Exhibition.

Recommend descriptive information to be included on display board per project:

- Name and location (city and province) of the project, including the name of the facility owner and an actual or projected completion date
- Credit block for each project that includes the firm name (including project consultants) or logo.
- Credit block should not be more than ½ ft. in height. The credit block should only recognize the specific disciplines provided on the project, and should not be a list of services provided by the firm(s). Do not use the AIA basic services list.

Recommend do not include the following on display board(s):

- Street addresses or telephone numbers for firms
- Names or photos of individual partners, designers, etc.
- Testimonials, quotations, certificates, facsimiles, or other comments about a project's worth
- Projections, including letters, or other loose attachments

Below are recommendations that are highly encouraged to include when designing your gallery board:

- When writing board copy, focus on the project, and not the firm.
- Use bold or high-contrast lettering for your displays with a minimum type size of 14 points.
- Text should not take up more than 1/3 of the board space.
- Use the following information which will be helpful to Gallery attendees:
 - Technical data
 - Narrative solution description
 - Unique features
 - Special program requirements
 - Construction costs
 - A list of materials selected
 - Bed capacity
 - o Unusual conditions of the problem
 - Total gross and net square feet
 - o Special equipment

How should I send my artwork?

These guidelines are vital so we ensure your graphics look the very best!

- 1. All logos must be in a vector format, saved in Adobe Illustrator or as an EPS file. Raster images will not be accepted this includes .jpg, .png or .gif files copied directly from a website.
- 2. All text should be converted to outlines or with the fonts provided. PC fonts only. All fonts must be embedded.
- 3. Photographic images should be 300 dpi at the final size in the layout in either JPG or TIF file format. Sorry, Internet images will not be used.
 - How an image is originally acquired will determine its resolution, and thus the size it can print at for clear and crisp printing.
 - Resolution and size (dimensions) are inversely proportional to each other. If you enlarge an image, you lower its resolution.
- 4. You must provide either a printed proof or a PDF proof when submitting artwork. This allows us to check the files for the font, color problems, missing links and more.


